#### Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Project implementation progress is advancing in all project countries, with several civil works contracts signed, contractors mobilized and works underway in Jarak and Novi Pazar (Serbia); in Berane and Bijelo Polje (Montenegro), at the Grand Circumference Channel (GOK) and along the Sava and Una dykes in Republika Srpska of BiH.



An Additional Financing for EUR 37 Million (US\$40.53 Million equivalent) to Bosnia and Herzegovina (BiH) under the First Phase of the Sava Drina Rivers Corridor Integrated Development Program (SDIP, P168862) was approved by the World Bank, with the aim to provide support to Brcko District (EUR 25 million) and Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina (EUR 12 million) to improve flood protection and environmental management.

#### Multiphase Programmatic Approach (MPA) Status

Phase 1 is under implementation and advancing. The preparation of Phase II is at the initial stages, involving mainly the conceptualization of key activities for Phase II.

Several contracts for embankment rehabilitation are currently under implementation across the project, but progress is still limited as some of the contractors have only recently mobilized and are therefore in the early phase of works, where work sites are being prepared and cleared, and cannot be classified as "rehabilitated" as per this indicator. Progress is ongoing, though.

The level and quality of participation will be measured through beneficiary assessments to be undertaken during project implementation at mid-term and again prior to project closure. Citizen Engagement (CE) reporting: The procurement process for the flood and drought monitoring and warning system has recently been launched and the contract is estimated to be awarded before the end of 2024. A first round of CE stakeholder consultations were carried out during the elaboration of the TOR for this activity with individual member countries of the ISRBC. Further CE consultations are planned as part of the implementation of the activity over the coming 18-24 months. The beneficiary assessments planned to be carried out around MTR are not yet due, as the MTR is being scheduled tentatively for October 2024. They will be carried out afterwards, in parallel to the implementation of the activity.


