


**Subject: Wildlife Conservation Society's parallel co-financing for the WWF GEF Child Project- Expanding and consolidating Madagascar's marine protected areas network GEF 9433: WWF-US G0012**

I am pleased to confirm that the Wildlife Conservation Society (WCS) is active in protecting Madagascar's marine biodiversity richness through the implementation and management of marine protected areas as well as through the promotion of locally managed marine areas/LMMA. Our on-the-ground intervention focuses on four key biodiversity areas, including three—Antongil Bay, North West seascape and the Deep South seascape—that are GEF prioritized sites. One of our objectives is to find mechanisms for sustainable financing of our work in these areas. As such, WCS seeks to achieve many of the same objectives and outcomes as the WWF-GEF-6 project.

WCS anticipates mobilizing an estimated USD 500,000 in the forthcoming four years for our conservation program in the three seascapes mentioned above. These may be considered as parallel in-kind co-financing towards the UNDP-GEF-6 project "**Expanding and consolidating Madagascar's marine protected areas network GEF9433: WWF-US G0012**", specifically for components 1 and 3 of the project. Any co-financing provided by WCS is contingent upon receipt of funding from our donors and agreement on the terms and conditions of WCS' engagement for the project.
