In my capacity as Head of Agricultural, Rural Development and Biodiversity Division of the French Development Agency, I confirm the AFD participation in the above mentioned GEF co-financed project through the Project "Agro-ecological intensification in Western Africa" funded by the Agency and implemented by the ECOWAS Commission through its Regional Agency for Agriculture and Food (ARAA).
