The CMU agrees with the Moderately Satisfactory ratings for both DO and IP in this ISR. We are glad to see the project continues to move forward in many fronts, including the completion of six calls for subprojects proposals and updated results, which show progress on key PDO and intermediate indicators.

As agreed during the last mission in October, we note that a formal request for a third restructuring has been submitted by the clients and the team is finalizing the package to reflect: (i) adjustments to the results framework and (iii) a reallocation between components and disbursements categories, which would allow the government to implement additional subprojects and achieve the PDO indicators.

During the coming months, it would be important to monitor the agreed action plan, including: (i) the finalization of the Coordination Agreement; (ii) the launch of the additional calls for proposals, (iii) the baseline definition and preliminary results for PDO Indicators 2 and 3; (iv) updated disbursement projections for the remaining of the project; and (v) procurement, FM, and safeguards-related next steps. We also encourage the team to proactively work with the authorities and the fiduciary teams to start preparing the ground for the last 12 months of implementation, including a monitoring strategy to ensure greater results focus, particularly in light of the political transition next year.

The CMU stands ready to provide support to the team as part of the intensive supervision schedule ahead.
