Dear Mr. Kurukulasuriya,

This is to inform you about the level of co-financing from the Ministry of Energy and Water for the GEF6 project –Promoting Sustainable Energy Access for Rural Communities in South-Eastern Angola.

During 2019-2023 period, the Ministry of Energy and Water plans to invest, on average,1 258 million Kwanzas per year from the General Budget resources, equivalent to USD 4 million annually or over USD 20 million over the five years for the implementation of solar energy systems and policies facilitating their adoption and use in Angola. This program will have a specific focus on rural areas where there is low possibility of getting supply of conventional electrical power through the national grid in the near future, such as Moxico and Cuando-Cubango as well as the provinces with similar characteristics.

These funds can be considered as co-financing for the afore-mentioned GEF project.

In my capacity as GEF Operational Focal Point for Angola, Chair of Southern Africa Constituency and GEF Council Member Through this letter, to inform you about the level of co-financing from the Ministry of Environment of the Republic of Angola for the GEF6 project "Promoting Sustainable Energy Access for Rural Communities in South-Eastern Angola".

During 2019-2023, the Ministry of Environment plans to invest, on average, 300 million kwanzas per year of General Budget resources, equivalent to US\$ 100 thousand annually or US\$ 500 thousand over five years, for the implementation of solar energy systems and policies facilitating their adoption and use in Angola.

This program will have a specific focus on rural areas with little current and future supply of conventional energy through the national grid, such as Moxico and Cuando-Cubango as well as provinces with comparable characteristics. These funds can be considered as co-financing for the afore-mentioned GEF project.
