


Project Theory of Change

Assumptions underpinning the Theory of Change conceptualised in Figure 1	
A1	Provincial rangeland policy is formally adopted
A2	Information / decision support system hosted by Punjab Forest Department is maintained and further developed post-project
A3	Stakeholders from various sectors participate in provincial and district mechanisms for cross-sectoral collaboration
A4	Livestock graziers and landowners can agree on community-level rangeland and livestock management plans, including policies to protect / restore rangeland ecosystems
A5	Local communities and institutions support increased participation of women in rangeland and livestock management structures
A6	Livestock graziers are willing to adopt new practices related to animal health and productivity, and provincial and district authorities provide co-financing to support these activities
A7	Local communities support increased participation of women in market value chains for livestock products and non-timber forest products
A8	Best practices and lessons learn on sustainable rangeland and livestock management adopted throughout the project area and by other provincial and national institutions and stakeholders
