## Implementation Status and Key Decisions

This ISR has been updated based on the information collected during the Implementing support mission undertook in Bamako by the Team from December 17 to 23, 2017.

The project is becoming more visible with the communication strategy that is under implementation. The improvement of the project is progressively reflected in the results framework as most of the intermediate indicators are on track. The team is expecting that the current momentum will be maintained. Following recommendations of the mid-term review held in February 2017, the project is being restructured to improve the pace of implementation and monitoring and evaluation.

The implementation of the Alternative Income Generating Activities is going well. To date, 454 sub-grants conventions (both communities and individual) were signed for a total of 12744 beneficiaries on which 9848 women (77,27%). 251 grants were already completed and 3 grants were canceled due to the inability of the beneficiaries to provide an acceptable site. The feedback received from 251 beneficiaries was positive. Most of the beneficiaries indicated the grants received allowed them to improve their livelihood conditions, they are paying school fees or their kids, they are supporting hospital costs, they are supporting hospital costs and they are developing the business to make it more sustainable. Some were able to hire additional workers. 200 grants are under implementation and will be subject to a beneficiary satisfaction assessment.

The Final independent review report of the Income Generating Activities report was delayed and it is now expected by end of January 2018. Due to the increased insecurity in Banamba and Nara Circles, new communes will be identified in Noro Circle. All current commitments at Banamba and Nara Circles will continue to be implemented but new commitments will be limited except if the security conditions improve.

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The indicator framework was proposed to be revised as follow:

PDO indicator dropped: "Changes (increase) in vegetation cover in targeted areas, compared to baseline". This indicator was proposed to be dropped due to potential attribution problems and lack of reliable counterfactuals. Vegetation cover, however, is an important part of the project and will be measured outside of the results framework using spatial information systems.

PDO indicator to be revised: from "Increase in land area with SLWM practices in targeted areas, compared to baseline (hectares reported by crop, range, forest, wetlands, protected areas)" to '*Land area under sustainable land and water management practices in targeted areas*'. The indicator has been proposed for revision for clarity and disaggregation has been dropped as distribution to each of the categories (crop, range, forest, wetlands, protected areas) would be difficult.

New PDO indicator: "Households with access to alternative livelihood activities related to sustainable land and water management practices supported by the project". The indicator has been proposed to be added to reflect the support to alternative livelihood activities and their relation to adoption of sustainable land and water management practices.

New PDO indicator: "Land area under sustainable landscape management practices". To ensure all aspects of the PDO are covered with indicator.

Revision of targets - the number of direct beneficiaries targets will be revised from 3,025 to 10,000 to reflect the activities,
