
I have the pleasure to confirm that Food and Agriculture Organization of Sri Lanka accepts to co-finance the GEF project "Enhancing and bridging knowledge gaps in Sri Lanka's NDC implementation of AFOLU sector for Enhanced Transparency Framework (ETF)" through our activities in Sri Lanka in 2019 to 2020. The co-financing will be through the following:

- GCP/SRL/063/GFF - Rehabilitation of degraded agricultural lands in Kandy, Badulla and Nuwara Eliya Districts in the Central Highlands

The co-financing contribution to the GEF project will be USD 200,000 and the component wise split is as follows:

- Component 1: Institutional arrangements to coordinate preparation of ETF reports for agriculture, land-use and other relevant sectors enhanced: USD 75,000
- Component 2: Capacity to assess and report emissions and removals from agriculture and land-use sectors and to design and monitor related emission reduction activities strengthened: USD 70,000
- Component 3: Capacity to implement, monitor and report *adaptation* activities and actions in agriculture and land-use sectors strengthened: USD 55,000
