

Project Title: "Sustainable Pathways – Protected Areas and Renewable Energy (SPPARE)"

Amendment No.4 to the PCA
Between

United Nations Environment Programme – Ecosystems Division
And
Department of Environment – Ministry of health and the Environment, Antigua and Barbuda

Pursuant to Clause 68 of the Project Cooperation Agreement (PCA) (Reference number: PCA/2015/004) signed on 21 April 2015 (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") between United Nations Environment Programme and the Department of Environment, Ministry of Health and the Environment, Antigua and Barbuda (hereinafter referred to as the "Parties") in support of the project titled: "**Sustainable Pathways – Protected Areas and Renewable Energy (SPPARE)**" (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"), the Parties hereto have agreed to amend the original Agreement (PCA/2015/004).

The purpose of the Amendment is to extend the duration of the Agreement at a no cost for a period of eighteen months from June 2023 to December 2024 to achieve the objectives of the Project.

1. General Provision

1.1. Agreement Clause 5: Duration and its footnote, is hereby amended as follows:

"This Agreement shall come into force upon signature of the Parties, being effective from the date of the latest signature, and shall remain in force until 31 December 2024¹ after the last obligation of the Parties lapse, unless terminated earlier, pursuant to clauses 52 to 63 of this Agreement." However, project effectiveness shall be the date of receipt by the Executing Agency of the first instalment of funds.

The total cost to the project to the GEF Trust Funds remains **unchanged**.

All other terms and conditions of the original PCA shall remain valid and unchanged. This amendment shall be appended to and be construed an integral part of the original PCA/2015/004 signed between UN Environment Programme and the Department of Environment, Ministry of Health and the Environment, Antigua and Barbuda on 21 April 2015.


