Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Since the last mission in July 2018, the project has made progress on implementation of project components. The mission noted that some progress has been made on the land and resource rights regularization component. Activities are well-identified and detailed terms of reference were completed in time.

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Some 10,700 lead farmers have been trained in climate-smart agriculture and over 200 farmer field schools established. Two community resource boards were established in Zumwanda and Chinunda, and boundary demarcation has commenced at the Lukusuzi National Park. Forest inventory has been completed for the forest reserves and training in community forest management done.

Moving forward, the project activities, and interventions will prioritize *Lukusuzi Landscape* and *Petauke Landscape* for concerted action, and with a view to achieving integrated management objective through targeted support across various land uses (Protected area, GMAs, Agriculture, communal forest etc.). Detailed actions to be reflected in the workplan were agreed.

The urgency of moving forward with activities to define the technical elements of REDD+ and the Emission reduction program design was discussed in order for GRZ to sign the ERPA and leverage results based payment from the BioCF-ISFL. The ToRs have been finalized since the mission, and consultancy procurement process has started,

The mission recommends a performance review to align PIU staffing with current business needs, PPIU should have more leeway in project implementation at the Eastern Province, and work collaboratively with key Ministries, Departments and Agencies in the Eastern Province, including Agriculture, Zambia Agriculture Research Institute (ZARI), Forestry, National Park and Wildlife, Physical Planning, Lands, Disaster Management and Mitigation, and the Provincial Administration. Better involvement of PPIU in project implementation will ensure better sectoral mainstreaming of investment; lessen the approval layers for faster decision-making, and lead to more efficient project implementation;

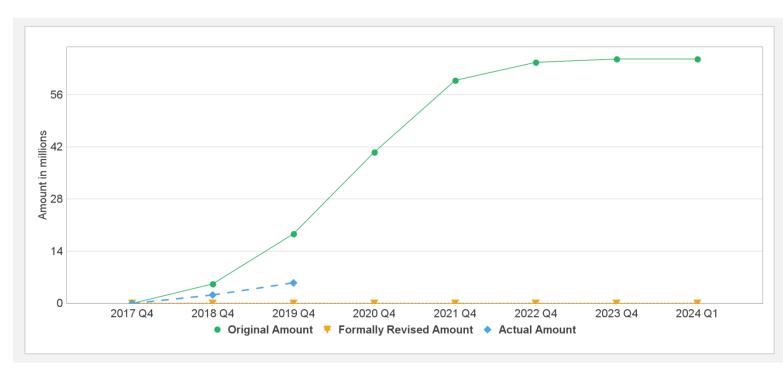
