I am pleased to inform you that I have cleared the Program Addendum detailed below for inclusion in the upcoming work program.

Noting that the child projects under this program 10804 are an addendum to program 10413 approved by Council in its December 2019 meeting, the program addendum 10804 in its entirety will be merged into program 10413 upon Council approval of the June 2021 Work Program. Except for the Program Commitment Deadline which is December 19, 2022 for the child projects approved under 10804 (the deadline for child projects approved under 10413 remains unchanged), all other milestones and program activities under 10804 will be monitored and reported under program 10413. By this letter, I would like to inform you that addendum 10804 will no longer be used upon Council approval of the June 2021 Work Program.


