Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Less than a year from the closing date of the project, the mission noted that the project has made considerable progress in the implementation of activities and considers that the development objectives may likely be achieved by the closing date in December 2023. The physical execution rates measured by the three Project Development Objective (PDO) indicators are at satisfactory levels such as: (i) area under desired soil management reached 1,761,277 hectares out of 1,500 planned at the end of the project, or 117.8 percent; (ii) farmers adopting improved agricultural technology reached the number of 3,071 against 3,000 at the end of the project; and (iii) proportion of target farmers with improved market access reached 59.81 percent against 35 percent at the end of the project.

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This performance is commendable insofar as the activities are still carried out in a particularly difficult political, economic, social and security context in Haiti, such as the deterioration of the security situation including the case of roadblocks, multiple kidnappings, and civil unrests, and fuel shortage, especially in provincial towns.
