1) Mostly 'YES', however, 1) it exceeds the 500 word limit (please make sure that there is no repetitions (e.g. the EA objective has been discussed already, etc.); 2) it would be good to mention in the summary how many countries will be supported by this Umbrella project (**39 countries**) to deliver faster and better national reports and specify other differences to the previous Umbrella projects.

2) In the results framework, it would be beneficial to specify activities/options under each output (training on PRAIS, Trends.Earth; capacity building on UNCCD/DLDD/SLM/LDN, reinforcement of CSOs, gender integration, inclusion of the youth, awareness campaign, training on Land-Use planning and LD/LDN, training on drought) that can be adjusted based on countries needs and capacity. Also the gender dimensions in all Outputs should be specified.

Regional entities are not mentioned in the implementation arrangements, while some of them were instrumental in past exercises: as PISLM in the Caribbean, OSS in Africa, the REC in Caucasus. Please, clarify, and add.

Provide more information on how they intend to ensure that countries engage with key stakeholders and consult with relevant NGOs/CSOs and interest groups when developing their national reports to the UNCCD.

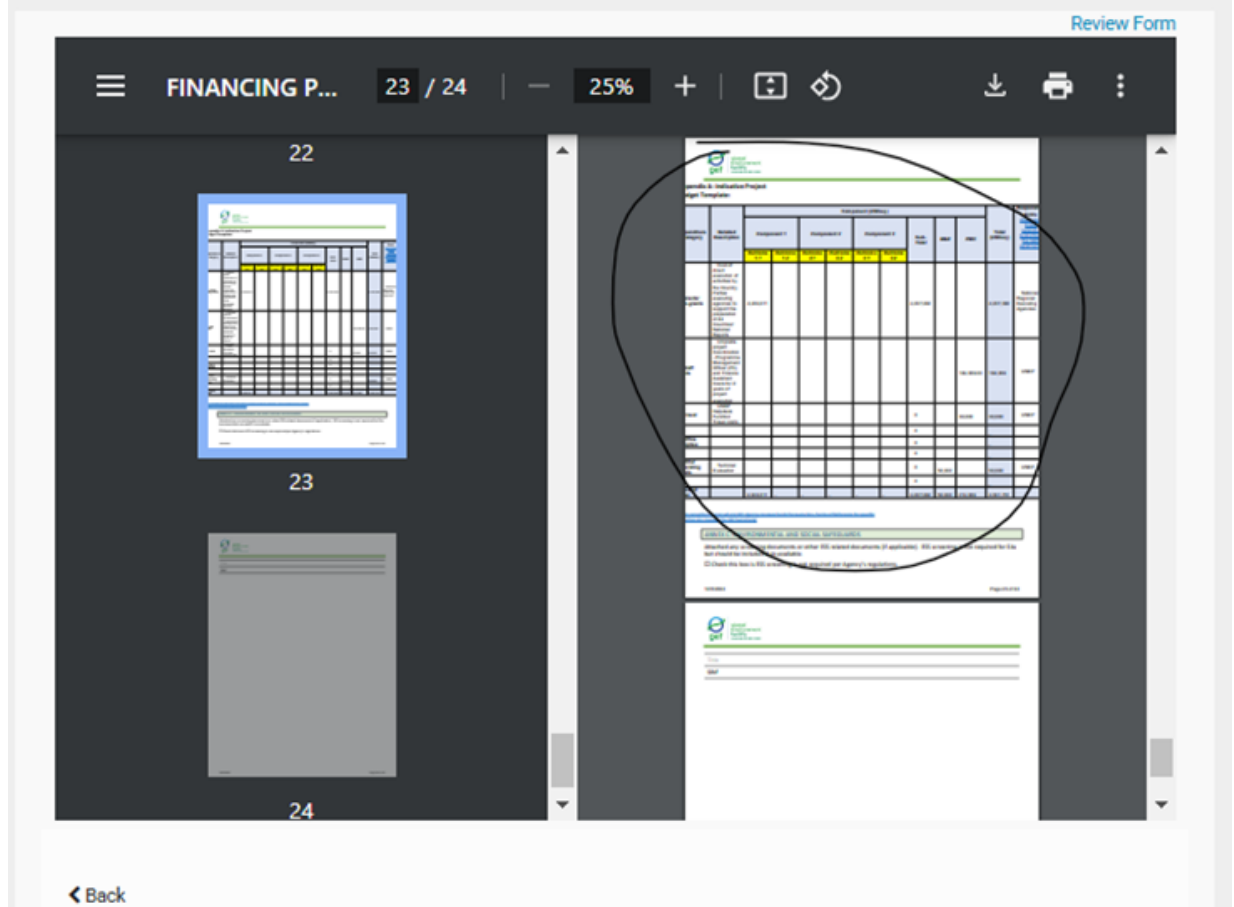

The Umbrella project includes 39 countries. However, only 35 LoEs are provided. There are two LoE for Comoros, apparently one of them for Cook Islands. And there is duplicate LoE Cameroon. There are none for Central African Republic, Ethiopia, Haiti and St. Lucia. Please make sure to include the missing LoEs at resubmission.

Jan 30, 2025

1. The wrong attachment has been linked to Mr. Gnapelet, the document that opens is the LoE from Cameroon. We looked for the LoE from Central African Republic (Country where Mr. Gnapelet is OFP) but we could not find it the documents section of the Portal. Please request the agency to include this letter.
2. The LoE from the Cook Islands is missing key information on the financing table, please request the agency to request a new LoE - the OFP must include the Source of Funds, Agency and Focal Area source data.
3. The LoE from Eswatini is missing the footnote. Please also request the agency to correct the Source of Funds from GEF to GEFTF.
4. Mensur Dessie Nuri is not the OFP from Micronesia, please request the agency to correct the name in the table.
5. The LoE from Grenada is missing the footnote ? please ask the Agency to get an email confirming the acceptance of the footnote (this is an alternative to a new LoE).
6. The LoE from Jamaica is missing the name of the OFP. Please request the agency to provide a letter that includes the name and contact information of Ms. Guthrie.

7. The LoE from Mauritania is missing the footnote related to the confirmation of the executing agency.
8. The LoE from The Gambia is missing the footnote - please ask the Agency to get an email confirming the acceptance of the footnote (this is an alternative to a new LoE).
