Only two people will be recruited to coordinate the project:

- one person will perform the coordinator's duties for 63.5% of her/his time and will use 36.5% of her/his time to perform the duties of the project's Technical Specialist.

- similarly, one person will use 70% of her/his time for the tasks of Administrative and Financial Assistant and 30% of her/his time to perform technical tasks related to operations. The ToRs for technical and managerial tasks are separated in two Annexes: i) Annex 6. Overview of Technical Subcontractors? for technical tasks and ii) Annex. 11 ToRs for Project Board and Project Team? for managerial tasks.
