B. PROPOSED PROJECT PREPARATION ACTIVITIES (\$)

Describe the PPG activities and justifications:

Guatemala has initiated the process to implement access to genetic resources and associated traditional knowledge (ABS), as well to ensure the equitable benefit sharing. The principles of equity and the issue of collective traditional knowledge represent highly complex issues to be addressed; however, this complexity contains inward two large national challenges: a) the social legitimacy of the process and b) the full and efective participation of the indigenous peoples and communities that own traditional knowledge. The ABS project of Guatemala aims to intiate the national dialogue on the issue of ABS, beginning with and informed citizenry, so that the instruments of human rights such as prior informed consent -PIC- are the cognitive basis of the participatory construction of this project.

In order to bring together the variables needed to ensure a participatory approach, solid baseline and a project designed to move Guatemala closer to ratification of the ABS Protocol, a number of preparatory activities are foreseen. These include 1) stakeholder consultations to ensure project design is in adherence to GEF's Public Involvement Policy; 2) gathering of existing baseline data and identification of gaps; and 3) developing criteria and methodologies to clearly link biodiversity management to local and rural development.
