We are very pleased that Kamanos State Strict Nature Reserve has been selected for implementation of biodiversity restoration and protection measures. This site represents unique wetland of international importance and contains values that are globally threatened. Recognising the significance of the project "Conservation of Inland Wetland Biodiversity in Lithuania", the Municipality of Akmenė within the economic capability will contribute to this project and reaching of its goals as well.

During the foreseen terms of the project municipality plans to allocate funds for:

1. Closure of Jučiai dumping site and clearing-out of the area – 4.000 LTL (1.140 USD)

NGO "Atgaja" is working in environmental protecting field 15 years already, and we enjoy promoting international importance UNDP/GEF project "Conservation of Inland wetland biodiversity in Lithuania".

We are going to start project "Waste management in Labanoras regional park's recreation territories" in 2003. Dear Sir,

Lithuanian Cranberry Growers Association from its very foundation in 1992 is working for the purpose to make large-fruited cranberry industrial plantations more popular. Workshops of local and international scale and scientific conferences are being held, including farmers and horticulturists as participants. Some of farmers – Association members already have their own cranberry plantations and are succeeding in this business.

Our Association has tight contacts with the scientists engaged in cranberry introduction and research works. Currently the biggest large-fruited cranberry collection is owned by Kaunas Botanical Garden of Vytautas Magnus University. Introduction and acclimatization investigations of more than 40 cultivars and breeding lines are carried out here, that's why most of workshops for cranberry growers are being organized at Kaunas Botanical Garden.

Besides Lithuania, Association has very good contacts and exchanges information with cranberry growers and scientists from Canada, USA, Germany, Byelorussia, Russia and neighboring Baltic countries.

For the last 3 years Association works very extensively with cranberry growers from Eastern Canada. Canadian counterparts have visited Lithuania for a few times, they got acknowledged with cranberry plantation growing achievements and problems in Lithuania, carried out consultations for the farmers and were interested in the possibilities of common business. The aims and future works of the "Conservation of biodiversity in Lithuanian marches" project No. LIT 01/G41 were introduced to them. Expertise results of Palios peat land, situated near Žuvintas state reserve, the same as Laukėsa peat land near Viešvilė state reserve expertise results were introduced to them. The fact that industrial cranberry plantations are planned to be established nearby with preserved territories, thus enabling to take away visitors from natural marshes and to protect their unique and especially sensitive biocenoses was appraised very high.

President of ROAR Company and owner of large industrial cranberry plantation in New Brunswick Mr. Daniel Arseneault has proposed to look for possibilities to establish plantation on co-operation basis, considering Laukėsa peat land in Tauragė district as a priority. Financial support from Canadian partners could be as high as 40 000 Lt (about 12 500 \$) for the first stage of establishing of pilot cranberry plantation at Laukėsa peat land.

It is considered that such investments could enable to establish cranberry plantation at Laukėsa peat land and to reduce cranberry pickers number at Viešvilė reserve, also creating new jobs for local village inhabitants. At the same time it would be an implementation of GEF project purposes.

Dzūkija National Park is going, in cooperation with project partners RDP International BV, Staatsbosbeheer (the Netherlands National Forest Service) and Lithuanian private advisory service Eurostadija, to start project "Collaborative management and multifunctional forest and landscape development in Dzūkija national park". In the frame of this project it is planned to create beekeeping farmstead and museum of apiculture in the Musteika village. Farmstead of traditional farming and crafts would be established in the Zervynos village. This project is closely related with project "Conservation of Inland Wetlands Biodiversity in Lithuania". Both villages are in the close vicinity to the Čepkeliai Strict Nature Reserve and local people use the nature resources of this protected area, negatively influencing ecological processes. Implementing of project would help to create new working places and would have educational effect, showing other possibilities to get money than seasonal collecting of forest goods. It is expected that traditional mushrooms and berries picking in the Nature Reserve will decreased and negative influence on nature will be reduced.

Dzūkija National Park and project partners RDP International BV, Staatsbosbeheer (the Netherlands National Forest Service) and Lithuanian private advisory service Eurostadija make a financial contribution of 46 700 USD for project "Collaborative management and multifunctional forest and landscape development in Dzūkija national park".

We hope that our investment will be beneficial for reaching of the project goals in Čepkeliai State Reserve.

Taking this opportunity we would like to express the gratitude for UNDP and your personal assistance in supervision of the project development phase of the UNDP/GEF project "Conservation of Inland Wetland Biodiversity in Lithuania" and participation of GEF experts in the development of the project itself.

The successful outcome of the project PDF-B phase is the full size project brief ready to be presented to GEF. Five most important Lithuanian wetlands: Čepkeliai, Kamanos, Viešvilė State Strict Nature Reserves, Žuvintas Biosphere Reserve as well as Girutiškis Strict Nature Reserve within the Labanoras Regional Park are finally nominated to be the Project sites. Selected project sites play very important role in the protection of inland wetland biodiversity in the country. Being located in the different geographical districts they represent the diverse mosaic of wetlands and wide spectrum of problems to be solved. All project sites are designated strict nature reserves, nevertheless lots of negative factors still affect the biodiversity and should be eliminated. Acting in wider than site scale, the project should fight the problems more efficiently and should bring more sustainability in wetlands management. Having highest protection status in the national scale the sites are also proposed Natura 2000 territories and listed among the sites protected under the Convention on Wetlands (Ramsar, Iran 1971).

The Ministry supports this project very much. Soundly tuned with other ongoing activities the project should bring new perspectives in wetland biodiversity protection strengthening socio-economic, public awareness public involvement, capacity building and other measures. It should build a basement for sustainable development of the sites and serve as a pilot for application in other areas.

The Ministry of Environment will do its best to raise all possible funds to contribute to the implementation of the project. According to our early estimates, we intend to allocate up to 13.794.000 LTL (3.941.000 USD), but taking into consideration the new tendencies in nature protection, actual contribution to reaching project goals through the project period might be bigger. The basic constituents of the contribution for the foreseen project implementation period are presented below:

- Improvement of legal basis (revision, preparation and initiation of approval of different legal documents (regulations, rules for strict nature reserve management planning, boundary delimitation etc.) - 187.000 LTL

The project "Full-Scale Woodland Key-Habitat Inventory in Lithuania" supported by Lithuanian Ministry of Environment and Swedish Environmental Protection Agency has started in 2001. A long-term objective of the project is to strengthen biodiversity conservation approach in forest management in Lithuania by providing substantial and lasting knowledge of valuable sites for forest biodiversity, inhibiting the forest unification process and improving conditions for survival/formation of more diverse forest habitats. The project is focusing on development of a methodological tools, an accomplishment of full-scale inventory of woodland key-habitats (WKH) in all forests in Lithuania, development of the database and routines for WKH protection and management.

The project managers have been informed about the UNDP/GEF project "Conservation of Inland Wetland Biodiversity in Lithuania" and consider the activities and goals of both projects very soundly tuned and beneficial for each other. Direct benefit from WKH project is WKH inventory in the surrounding forests of Viešvile strict nature reserve, where GEF project plans to introduce diverse spectrum of biodiversity conservation measures. Total investments from WKH project in the Viešvile surroundings are planned as much as 5.700 USD and could be considered as a direct contribution in reaching GEF project goals.

The engagement of our Biological Station and Frankfurt Zoological Society in the Restauration of Kamanos strict Nature Reserve

Dear Gediminas,

since 1999 we are engaged in the restauration work and in rising the public awareness in and for Kamanos strict nature reserve. In the following, I will summarize this engament in the past and what we wont to do in the future:

1. The first donation of the Frankfurt Zoological Society was done in 1999 for building dams in the southern and eastern parts of the peat bog; together with our visit in july 1999 (20.-23.7.), we spent altogether about 10.000,- €.
2. In june 2000 we received the letter from Frankfurt Zoological Society for the second donation. Our next visit in Kamanos took place in April 2001 (6.-13.4.), where we imported the car for Kamanos and several tools for the restauration and scientific work. In april 2002 we were again there (1.-7.4.) an discussed the future necessities, concerning the GEF-project, together with Mrs. Risager from Denmark. In june 2002, Dr. Wolfgang Schwöppe was alone again in Kamanos to help in the restauration work. Altogether this was an amount of about 50.000,- €.
3. Meanwhile we have – on the background of our discussions concerning the forthcoming of the GEF-Project in Kamanos – asked Frankfurt Zoological to make a third donation of 100.000 € for buying land in buffer zone to realize further rising of the water level especially in the northern and eastern parts of the peat bog during the next 4 years. Together with our own efforts, this "third phase" will have an amount of totally 150.000,- €.

At the moment we plan to visit Kamanos again from 13.-17. april 2003.

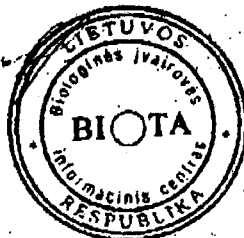

OMPO (Migratory Birds of the Western Palearctic) is an international NGO - member of the IUCN and permanent observer at the Council of Europe - which aim at improving knowledge on migratory birds and developing programs to conserve their habitats, mainly wetlands.

We have been informed about implementation of the UNDP/GEF project "Conservation of Inland Wetland Biodiversity in Lithuania" and we take this opportunity to express our thanks to the GEF program for supporting projects on wetland conservation worldwide, including Lithuania, where OMPO has been involved since 1996 and has its local unit - the public agency "OMPO Vilnius".

In this country, OMPO has funded in 1996-1999 the inventory of important wetlands including 5 Ramsar sites (for 25,000 Euros), which are presently concerned by the GEF project. Results of this inventory were published in the book "Important Wetlands in Lithuania"¹ that was provided to wetlands managers and local authorities as a tool for conservation of biodiversity of Lithuanian wetlands.

In order to ensure effective implementation of the SAPARD programme, the National Paying Agency under the Ministry of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as Agency) has been established in accordance with a decree of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania.

According the National Rural Development Programme for 2002-2006, implementation of SAPARD sub-measure: Environmentally friendly agricultural methods shall start after all required details of this sub-measure are defined and final agreement with European Commission is reached. The main objective of agri-environment programme is to decrease negative impact of agriculture on the environment, restore traditional landscape and increase the biodiversity, to prepare measures that ensure normal economic and social conditions for rural population. The sub-measure will be applicable in three pilot areas. Those areas cover Silute, Pasvalys, Birzai districts and 5 neighbourhoods in the territory of Dovine River (Zuvintas Lake) Basin. Total amount of 2,832,000 euros is to be provided for agri-environmental sub-measure for the 2002-2006 year period.

It is expected that farmers and land owners having more than 3 ha of land will be eligible to receive support for this measure in the amount of up to 10,000 euros for one applicant. After signing a contract with the Agency, a farmer will have to implement obligatory measures for 5 years period. For instance, land owner keeping his agricultural practice must follow higher environmental standards than those stated in the national legislation. While implementing specific measures



Public Agency "Soil remediation technologies" under the Ministry of Environment is the only ministerial subdivision mainly focusing on practical environmental management. The agency is involved in effective reclamation and restoration of contaminated land, however basing on increasing need for wetland restoration and management it reallocated part of existing capacities for this purpose.

The agency was informed about the UNDP/GEF project "Conservation of Inland Wetland Biodiversity in Lithuania" and finds the solid ground for cooperation on the restoration of wetlands as well as improvement of certain recreational areas. Following the recommendations issued by the Ministry of Environment, agency intends to purchase efficient and new to Lithuania machinery – "Watermaster" (produced by Finnish company "Aquamec") for this purpose. On behalf of the State Service for Protected Areas under the Ministry of Environment I would like to express the overall support to the project "Conservation of Inland Wetland Biodiversity in Lithuania".

Selected project sites are among the most valuable wetlands and represent different geographic districts of the country. Site importance is internationally recognized - 4 sites are protected under the Convention on Wetlands (Ramsar, Iran 1971) and all of them are proposed Natura 2000 sites. 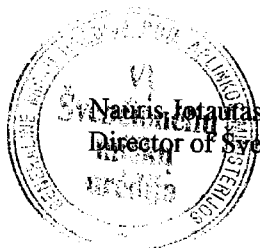
