A major amendment is requested for this project because three (3) additional countries have expressed interest in joining (Benin, Ukraine and Vanuatu) and have sent endorsement letters. Their participation has resulted in an increase of more than 5% in the overall amount requested at CEO endorsement (US\$ 6,210,000) compared to the overall indicative amount requested at PIF stage (US\$ 5,400,000).

Several countries approached UN Environment, UDP and UNFCCC Secretariat at COP22 to request support for TNA. As follow-up, UN Environment approached the GEF Secretariat to request their agreement to include additional countries which clearly emphasize technology as a key element to implement their NDC and show a strong commitment/motivation to join TNA Phase III.

In February 2017, with agreement by the GEF Secretariat (see supporting correspondence), UN Environment reached out to the climate change officials and GEF OFPs of 14 countries that had requested support for TNA as a means to support/inform NDC implementation asking them to submit their endorsement letter and specifying that only LDCs and SIDS would benefit from the set-aside while other countries would have to commit their STAR allocations.

Three countries submitted their endorsement letters before the proposal was finalized and submitted to the GEF: Benin and Vanuatu which are respectively LDCs and SIDS eligible for the global set-aside funds, and Ukraine which committed funds from its GEF STAR allocation. In April 2017, the GEF Secretariat confirmed that the financing was available for the 3 additional countries and requested UN Environment to submit the CEO endorsement document with a major amendment (see supporting correspondence).

We understand that the GEF Council must approve this major amendment and we look forward to being informed of the posting date for Council Review and any comments that are received in that window.
