Dear Council Member:

I am writing to notify you that UNDP, the Implementing Agency for the project entitled, *Regional: Addressing Transboundary Environmental Issues in the Caspian Environment Programme*, has submitted the proposed project document for CEO endorsement prior to final approval of the project in accordance with UNDP procedures.

Over the next four weeks, the Secretariat will be reviewing the project document to ascertain that it is consistent with the proposal included in the work program approved by the Council in October 1998, and with GEF policies and procedures. The Secretariat will also ascertain whether the proposed level of GEF financing is appropriate in light of the project's objectives.


Subject: *Regional: Addressing Transboundary Environmental Issues in the Caspian Environment Programme*
