ENDORSEMENT OF SOUTH WEST INDIAN OCEAN FISHERIES PROJECT (SWIOFP): SOUTH AFRICAN GEF FOCAL POINT

The development of the South West Indian Ocean Fisheries Project (SWIOFP) is nearing completion and will soon be in an appraisal phase. Preparation of the project to date has been a collaborative effort between officials from nine countries, under the leadership of Dr. William Leeds Lane from the World Bank.
