The study should be based on a rapid needs assessment, consultation with key stakeholders and suggestion of SLM technical solutions that would complement IFAD's operation in Maradi region. The study should provide elements for project design focusing on activities and sites where global environmental benefits could be yielded. The baseline study will also provide baseline values for the project log frame and cost elements for project design and costing.			
2. Review of bottlenecks and barriers to SLM in the Maradi region: This study will provide a comprehensive assessment of the institutional, financial and technical barriers to SLM in Maradi. It will provide the basis to further strengthen the rationale for the GEF investments and identify the key investment needs. The study will pay particular attention to barriers that hinder SLM at the local level (crop/livestock conflicts, access to land and natural resources, tradition systems for SLM etc).
