Following careful consideration of the various strengths of the two agencies (UNEP and UNDP) in regard to assisting Uzbekistan to implement the NCSA process the National Operational Focal Point, the relevant National Convention Focal Points (i.e. FP's for Biodiversity, Climate Change and Combating Desertification Conventions) and other key "in-country" stakeholders have reached a decision that UNDP would be preferable.

This decision was based principally on the knowledge that UNDP, through its joint Environmental Programme in Uzbekistan, has greater national capacity to assist Uzbekistan in regard to the practical NCSA implementation.
